This FULL Day workshop will include a variety of acting techniques Diane has collected from her early years at Julliard to her success on Broadway and in headlining films. She will incorporate her experience working with Patsy Rodenburg (*National Theatre Co*), David Mamet, and Cicely Berry (*Royal Shakespeare Co*). Students must come prepared with a one-minute monologue.

Diane Venora is a leading stage, television and film actress who attended the Julliard School on scholarship. She has performed Shakespeare extensively, starring in Joseph Papp's production of *Hamlet* at the New York Shakespeare Festival. She was the first American to play the title role at the prestigious showcase. She has a long history with *Hamlet*, playing *Ophelia* opposite **Kevin Kline** and *Gertrude* onscreen opposite **Ethan Hawke**. TV credits include *Law & Order*, *Chicago Hope*, *NCIS* and *Grey's Anatomy*. Film credits include *Heat* with **Robert DeNiro** and **Al Pacino**, *Romeo+Juliet* with **Leonardo DiCaprio** and **Claire Danes**, and *The Insider* with **Russell Crowe**, **Al Pacino** and **Christopher Plummer**.
